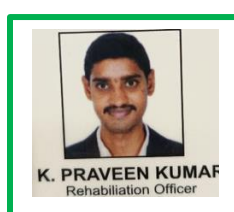

About the sensitization Programme:

- The target age group for the program are students and faculty of Vikrama Simhapuri University, Nellore. The programme hopes to positively influence and impact the attitudes and behaviour of the youngsters towards the differently-abled. They are the next generation of decision-makers – employers, service providers, business owners, advocates, policymakers – teachers, colleagues, neighbours and friends. And this programme also covers Mental Health Rehabilitation Programme i.e., Kiran which is launched by the **Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, a 24/7 toll-free helpline ‘Kiran’** to provide **support to people facing anxiety**, stress, depression, suicidal thoughts and other mental health concerns. It will **offer mental health rehabilitation services** with the objective of early screening, first-aid, psychological support, distress management, promoting positive behaviours, etc.

In this backdrop, Department of Social Work, Vikrama Simhapuri University, in association with Composite Regional Centre, (Administrative control of National Institute of Empowerment of Persons with Intellectual Disabilities- NIEPID), (Divangajan) , Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India is conducting Sensitization Programme on “Disability and Mental Health Rehabilitation ” on 04/08/2022.

About the University:
